Overview And Policy

WellCare's mission is to enhance our members' health and quality of life while partnering with providers and governments to provide high-quality, cost-effective health care solutions. WellCare engages in political and public policy efforts to help further that mission and positively benefit our members, our industry and the communities in which we operate. We believe it is our responsibility to work with policy makers in an ethical and transparent manner.

The following report details political activities and expenditures during calendar year 2018. The information represents spending authorized by WellCare's Government Affairs function and is accurate to the best of the company's knowledge.

WellCare participates in the public policy process in many ways, including:

- Implementing a comprehensive government affairs strategy designed to inform elected and appointed officials of key public policy issues related to the company's business;
- Political giving through an associate-funded federal political action committee and corporate political giving; and
- Membership in industry trade associations.

WellCare's Commitment To Integrity

- All political contributions are directed to promote the interests of WellCare and are made without regard to the private political preferences of WellCare's officers and executives.
- WellCare's policy on corporate political activity describes the types of organizations and candidates considered to be appropriate recipients of the company's political spending, including specific criteria for making or approving political expenditures with corporate funds.
- No campaign contribution will be given in anticipation of, in recognition of, or in return for, an official act.



WellCare's Commitment To Transparency

- In compliance with federal and state law, WellCare discloses contributions made and received in reports filed with the Federal Election Commission and the respective state regulatory agencies.
- WellCare annually discloses political expenditures to candidates, political party committees, political action committees ("PACs"), caucus committees, entities organized under section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code (also known as "527 organizations") and social welfare organizations created under section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- WellCare publicly discloses on its website information regarding its political contributions and expenditures.

WellCare's Commitment To Compliance

- The Board of Directors, through its Audit, Finance and Regulatory Compliance Committee, monitors the company's political activities, including corporate and PAC expenditures.
- Outside legal counsel provides guidance concerning corporate political activities and conducts regular audits to assess compliance with WellCare's internal policies and procedures.
- WellCare's Code of Conduct and Business Ethics includes provisions regarding interacting with government employees and lobbying, and the company requires annual training for all associates concerning compliance with corporate political activity laws and policies.
- Pursuant to federal and state guidelines, WellCare and each of its subsidiaries prohibit the use of contract dollars to carry out its political activities.

Lobbying Activities

WellCare is committed to the highest ethical standards when engaging in political activities. Accordingly, WellCare complies with all federal and state laws and regulations for lobbying registration and reporting. All lobbying registrations and reporting of expenditures are done in strict compliance with these laws.

Pursuant to the Lobbying Disclosure Act, WellCare files federal lobbying reports quarterly with the Office of the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives and the Secretary of the U.S. Senate. These reports, which are available at <https://lobbyingdisclosure.house.gov> and www.senate.gov/legislative/lobbyingdisc.htm#lobbyingdisc=lda respectively, describe issues lobbied and the amount spent on lobbying activities. In addition, WellCare files state lobbying reports with the appropriate state governing agencies in compliance with each state's respective requirements. These reports are publicly available in the jurisdictions. And, WellCare and each of its health plan subsidiaries, as well as associates engaged in lobbying activities and retained external lobbyists and firms, register as required to represent the company's interests.

Political Contributions

Like many other companies, WellCare engages in the practice of making corporate political contributions where permitted. In addition, WellCare sponsors a voluntary associate-led Political Action Committee (the “WellCare PAC”) that allows eligible associates and shareholders to pool their resources to support federal and state candidates and political committees who share our commitment to delivering comprehensive, high-quality health care to our nation’s most vulnerable populations.

In making political contributions, WellCare and the WellCare PAC are guided by strong governance principles and practices. We are committed to complying with federal and state campaign finance laws and regulations and with all applicable reporting obligations. And, we have established strict internal policies, processes and compliance mechanisms to ensure adherence to all legal and regulatory requirements.

Industry Associations And Coalition Participation

WellCare is a member of, and actively participates in, a variety of industry associations and coalitions that advocate on matters of importance to the industry on behalf of their members. These groups participate in the political process through educational initiatives and lobbying efforts on legislative and regulatory decisions that impact WellCare and the populations we serve.



WellCare PAC

The WellCare PAC enables eligible associates and shareholders to voluntarily pool their political contributions to support federal and state candidates who understand the legislative and regulatory issues important to our company and our industry and who, like WellCare, believe in the importance of delivering comprehensive, high-quality health care to our nation's most vulnerable populations.

About The PAC

WellCare Health Plans, Inc., established and sponsors a political action committee, which is registered with the Federal Election Commission (“FEC”) and with state regulatory authorities as required by applicable law. The WellCare PAC is a separate segregated fund (or “SSF”) under federal law, to which WellCare solicits contributions only from its eligible associates. Copies of reports filed by the WellCare PAC with the FEC can be found by searching for “WellCare PAC” at www.fec.gov/finance/disclosure/candcmte_info.shtml.

PAC staff work closely with leadership to manage the operation of the PAC. The WellCare PAC is governed not only by FEC regulations and applicable federal and state laws but also by internal policies and procedures to ensure full compliance of the PAC's activities. Contributions to the WellCare PAC are entirely voluntary. Distributions from the WellCare PAC are made on a non-partisan basis and in accordance with established criteria, including:

- Stated positions on key issues of business concern;
- Geographic concentration of WellCare associates and/or members;
- Committee assignments and/or leadership positions; and
- Viability.

- Whether they represent a district or state where a WellCare office or a significant membership population resides;
- Their committee standing and ranking;
- Their caucus leadership position; and
- Their stated position on matters important to the enterprise.

WellCare Government Affairs staff consult with external legal counsel to ensure that all contributions are consistent with applicable statutes, regulations, limits and guidelines. And, all contributions are reviewed and approved prior to payment.
